- The GBRUSBC must receive the completed application with attachments by April 30th of the year you are applying for you to be considered in this scholarship program.
- The applicant must also be available for an in person interview with the Scholarship Committee as a follow up to this application.
- Scholarship award will be paid to the institution applicant has applied for or deposited into the USBC Smart Program. Under no circumstances will the award be paid directly to the applicant.
- The decision of the GBRUSBC is final regarding all scholarship matters, including, but not limited to the interpretation of information on this application, and the recipient selection process.
